

Treasure Hunt Builder – treasurehuntbuilder.com

Theme – Help the Homeless

The object of this Treasure Hunt is to solve all the clues and find the Treasure! The clues point to the following locations:

Inside a Flashlight (Remove the batteries and put the clues inside)

Inside a Jacket in the Closet (Put the clues in a jacket pocket)

In the Freezer in a Bag (Put the clues in a bag in the freezer)

Under the Telephone (Leave the clues loose under the telephone)

In a Box of Cereal (Use an empty cereal box for the treasure)

The person who controls the Treasure Hunt is called the Hunt Master.

Hunt Master:

Cut up the clues, keeping the first ones, and leave them in order at the locations above. Decide on the treasure. This is something that can be hidden at the last location. You can use a box or bag filled with candy, coins, or coupons. It's a good idea to have consolation prizes as well. Since everyone will be directed to the same location, make sure there are enough copies of the clue at that location for those who are not first to arrive.

Designate Teams. The theme for the hunt is indicated above. You can name your teams accordingly or not name them at all. Distribute the first clue to the players or teams. You can deliver the first clue in a decorated envelope or in a box with a few prizes. Or you can read them the first clue.

Tell them to begin. Keep an eye on how each player or team is doing and provide help for those who fall behind. Let them know they can ask you for help.
