## Theme - Around the Classroom - Primary Level

The object of this Treasure Hunt is to solve all the clues and find the Treasure! The clues point to the following locations:

On top of the bookshelf

Under the wastebasket

In the sink

On the window sill

Under the TV

The person who controls the Treasure Hunt is called the Hunt Master.

### **Hunt Master:**

Cut up the clues, keeping the first ones, and leave them at the locations above. Decide on the treasure. This is something that can be hidden at the last location. You can use a box or bag filled with candy, coins, and/or toys. It's a good idea to have consolation prizes as well. Since everyone will be directed to the same location, make sure there are enough copies of the clue at that location for those children/teams who are not first to arrive.

Designate Teams. The theme for the hunt is indicated above. Name your teams accordingly. If there are no teams (just individual players) you can skip this. Distribute the first clue to the players or teams. You can deliver the first clue in a decorated envelope or in a box with a few prizes. Or you can read them the first clue.

Tell them to begin. Keep an eye on how each player or team is doing and provide help for those who fall behind. Let them know they can ask you for help.

Alternately, you can have the students raise their hands when they think they have solved the clue. Ask them to designate one member of the team to find the clue and then read it to the rest of the class. This method keeps the chaos to a minimum.
